



Fulbright-Israel Senior Specialist Fellowships **2010/2011**

The Senior Specialist Program provides support for short (2-6 week) visits to Israel by American academics or senior professionals in the following fields:

The program of work for a senior specialist's visit may include activities such as lecturing to undergraduate or graduate students; professional consultations and advising; participation in workshops or conferences; development and/or evaluation of academic curricula; etc. The program does not fund research.

An annual quota of 10 visit approvals has been allocated to the Fulbright Israel program. The program budget provides the specialist with reimbursement of round trip airfare (tourist class) and a \$200/day honorarium. In-country hospitality (lodgings, meals, in-country transportation) is provided by the Israeli host institution/s, according to terms agreed in direct contacts between the program fellow and the institution/s concerned.

Applications for 2009/2010 visits may be submitted beginning from the October 20, 2010 deadline (see <http://www.cies.org/specialists/Joining The Roster/Peer Review.htm#review> for 2010/2011 application deadlines). The response to an application is received after approximately 2 months. Approved visits may begin 3-4 months after the application date.
